FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Sedestrom reported that the year-end processes are proceeding and that the preliminary statements have been included in the board packet. He highlighted that the General fund shows an initial surplus of \$2.25 million but that the final number will change since many adjustments are still needing to be made as further bills are paid and adjusting entries are made. Any surplus would be earmarked for the capital improvement reserves. He also reported that the Self-Insurance fund continues to perform incredibly well and shows a preliminary year-end fund balance of over \$9.6 million. Because of this strong balance, the

monthly amount of employer contribution to the fund is being reduced from \$300,000 to \$250,000 for 2025.

She continued with information about one of the most popular free programs opening January 27, AARP's tax help. The program will be held at nine locations this year, including the Main Library.

Ms. Baier invited the board to the new Studio, or expanded Maker Space, grand opening coming February 11 at 1 PM.

She mentioned she, Ms. Michael-Keller, and Ms. Bolan would be attending Indiana Library Federation State House Day on February 3, 2025, to meet with legislators to advocate for libraries.

Ms. Baier encouraged the trustees to look at two exhibits currently on display at the Main Library, the United States Colored Troops in the Rolland Center, and the History of Fair Housing in the Great Hall.
