THE DAVID HARTS COLLECTION OF ILLINOIS MAPS

Historical Note

The David Harts Collection of Illinois Maps comprises twenty-five maps gathered by David Harts, an attorney and philanthropist from Lincoln, Illinois. Upon Harts's death, the collection was acquired by James T. Hickey (1922-1996) of Elkhart, Illinois. Hickey was a collector and dealer of Lincolniana and was curator first of the Lincoln College Lincoln Museum and then of the Henry Horner Lincoln Collection in the Illinois State Historical Library (1966-1993). The Louis A. Warren Lincoln Library and Museum, predecessor of The Lincoln Museum and the Lincoln Financial Foundation Collection, purchased the Harts Collection from Hickey in August 1981.

Scope and Content

The twenty-five maps in the David Harts Collection were published between 1788 and 1871. Eighteen are maps of early Illinois or parts of Illinois or of Illinois and its neighboring states. Seven are maps of the United States or regions within the United States that include Illinois. The collection as a whole documents the changing geographical configuration of Abraham Lincoln's Illinois.
